Climax: What is the sudden turning point/"moment they've been waiting for"? What changes because of this?	Falling Action: Was it a win or a loss for the protagonist (main character), and what do they have to do in order to resolve the conflict from the beginning?	Resolution: How does the story end? How does this change/affect the characters? Is it the ideal situation for the characters/story?
